Critical, Important and Technology Needs:

→ Critical – Science classrooms in 300 wing. Marti :History in development of this wing – the previous bond was to have a double classroom; with a lab and set of computer banks and lecture area. Plan was changed to add classrooms; safety and fire code each sink allotted 4 students; lab/lecture would have been fine. Capped at 27 per class. 8th gr. Area has vent hood in storeroom. Vent hood in each classrooms. Get students accustomed to the safety. More rooms and computers. Karl thinks 3 kids per class too many now; safety issue. Current classroom size should have 20 per class. Small store room. Cannot do some experiments because lack of sprinkler system. Instead of current 6 classrooms would have been 3 double rooms. Before were in the dungeon in 100 wing. Sinks being dropped for ADA. Wing 300 sinks fine for ADA. Issue with humidity in floors in 300 wing. Concrete was not sealed when slab was put in. In current bond program to repair.

→ Enclose vestibule; rear of building. Outside passing area in the rear of building. 7th and 8th grade use as easy access – exposed to road and parking area. Not covered. Wrestled with fencing, limiting car access. Option maybe to enclose stairwells and put additional classrooms in there.

Student bus pickup and dropoff: Only one entry point into WR. See traffic study plan.

Susan Glover – Fine Arts Dept.: Additional classrooms, workspace for staff, storage area.
Orchestra – would like a larger ensemble room and storage for music library.
