Thank you for agreeing to serve on the EISD Community Bond Advisory Committee. We have developed a committee with representation from parents and staff members who are committed to providing input for a future bond proposal. We are ready to move forward with our initial meeting, which is scheduled for Friday, August 21, 2009, starting at 7:45 a.m. in the Westlake High School Lecture Hall.
